Regarding Publication of PSVP Innovation and Startup Policy

Chennai, India as one of the recognized engineering and highly ranked, skill based, higher education institute, would like to be part of this initiatives. As per the instructions given by the MoE's Innovation cell, NISP implementation committee is constituted at PSVPEC to frame, implement, amend and monitor Institutional Innovation Entrepreneurship and Start-up Policy.
